

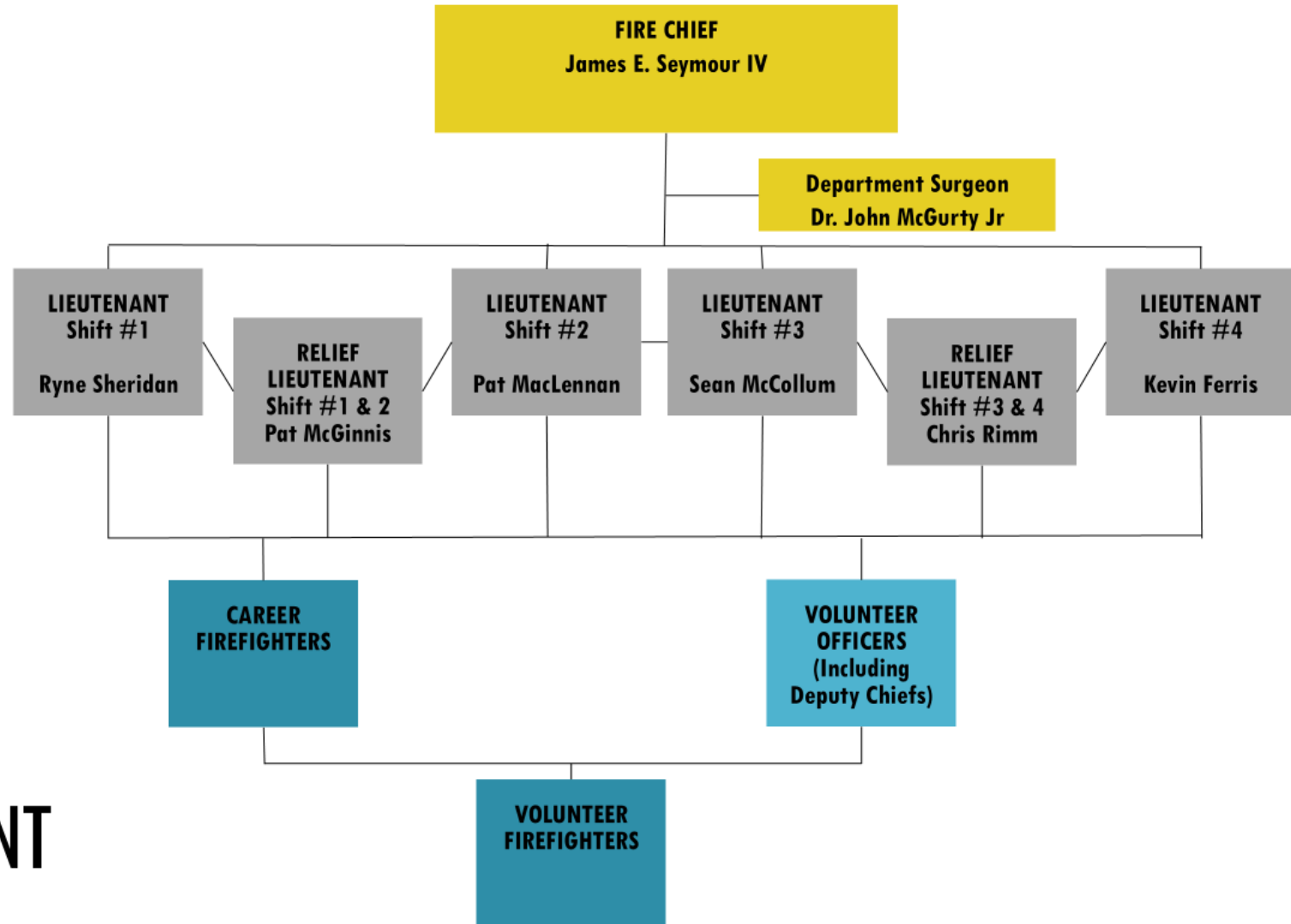
CITY OF PEEKSKILL FIRE DEPARTMENT
