Clayton and the other Board of Ethics members assured Mr. Rivera he was being heard and thanked him for coming in.

Motion made by Jacqueline Gares to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Clayton Keene. Motion passed unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 7:27pm.
