REQUIREMENTS for DEMOLITION PERMIT

Requirements

- A. Complete Demolition Permit Application. Submit with proper fees.
- B. Asbestos identification and removal as per New York State Industrial Code Rule #56.
- C. A letter from Con Edison – stating the Gas and Electric has been removed.
- D. Disconnect Water Service, as per requirement of the Water Department.
- E. Disconnect Sanitary Sewer and Storm lines, as per requirements of the Department of City Services, Bureau of Public Works.
- F. Copy of Telephone Company notification of intent to demolish.
- G. Copy of Cable TV notification of intent to demolish.
- H. All oil and propane gas storage facilities shall be removed from site and disposed of properly prior to demolition.
- I. Provide adequate means of dust control. (Hydrant use Permits are available through the Peekskill Water Department).
- J. Copy of Contractors:
 - 1. Worker's Compensation insurance.
 - 2. Certificate of Liability
 - 3. Certificate of Disability
 - 4. Westchester County Home Improvement Certificate

All Certificates must list - City of Peekskill, 840 Main St. Peekskill NY 10566

Equipment

- A. Dumpsters (if used), are allowed on private property. Should the public property be used, (i.e., Sidewalk, street, etc.), a permit must be obtained, prior to work starting.
- B. All corrodible and combustibles are to be removed from the site and disposed of properly.
- C. All concrete/slabs may be used as fill, provided they are broken into small pieces to allow for drainage, or they must be removed from the site.
- D. Site must be restored with appropriate materials, graded and seeded.
- E. Tracking pad may be required to prevent dirt and run off onto City streets.
- F. Silt fences may be required to prevent water and dirt run off to adjoining properties and streets.
- G. Safety fences may be required to prevent non - authorized persons from entering the job site.
